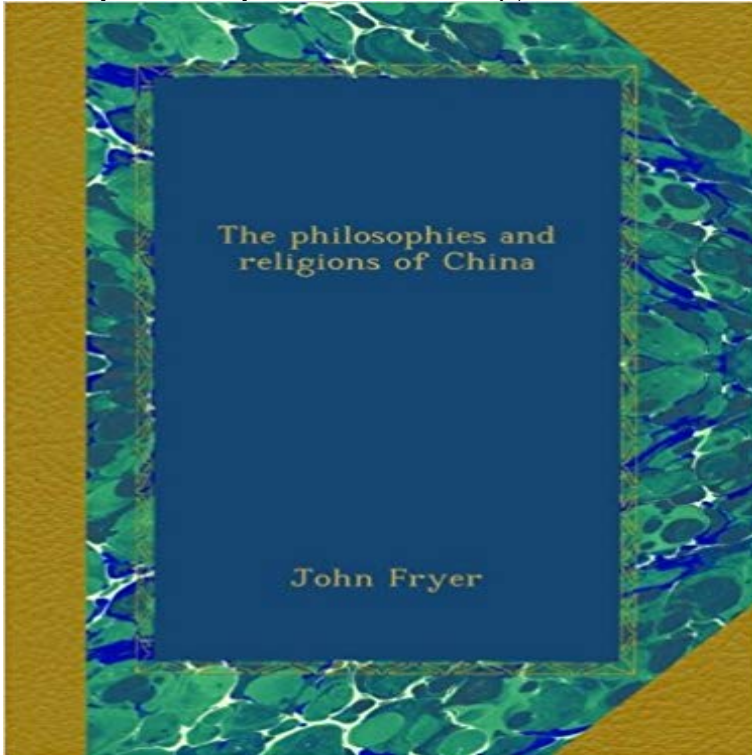


## The philosophies and religions of China
